Splitting ASD will increase taxes?

ASD has increased taxes 6 times in the past 10 years, including 2024. A study by LRB Public Finance concluded that a new, local school district would result in tax savings compared to staying with ASD.

Programs will be lost?

Alpine School District is currently proposing changes to programs across the district and closing schools with little or no input from the impacted communities. SPED, ALL, CTE, and DLI would all be better served by allowing each area to customize the programs they offer to their students.

Teachers will leave?

Teachers are guaranteed the same pay & benefits through the early transition period. Teachers who support Prop 11 recognize that it is best for students and it could result in better pay & benefits for teachers through more competition between the new districts.

Now isn't the time?

If we don't split now, the problems of overcrowded schools, closing schools, and rising taxes will only get worse. There is no guarantee that we can pass another bond. Now is the time to do the right thing for students.
